Who is the main presenter of the Story of the Daughter of Zion?

Anya McKee is the keynote speaker at DOZ events. Anya has decades of experience in church planting and leadership, discipleship and mentoring, cross-cultural ministry and personal prayer ministry. Her latest book, *Feels Like I'm Breathing*, tells her own poignant story of breaking down strongholds and discovering a Gospel more glorious than she'd ever imagined. She and her husband, Jeff, are the founders of Torn Curtain Collective, a ministry that equips and empowers God's people to live as confidently, naturally and effectively in the spiritual realm as they do in the physical.

What does a DOZ retreat package include?

Pre-event leadership meet and greet

3 x compelling, hour-long spoken word / teaching sessions

Printed DOZ Outline card and verse booklet for every guest or attendee

OPTIONAL: Drama and vocal interludes (availability will be confirmed for your dates and location)

Prophetic worship team (or in conjunction with your worship team/leader)

Pre-event ministry team equipping session

Personal or corporate prayer ministry, either with Anya, or with your team.

How much does it cost to host Anya and the Daughter of Zion team?

Our aim at Torn Curtain Collective is to make the DOZ Presentation available as generously as possible. The cost for the DOZ presentation is set at \$25 per guest, which can be collected beforehand or paid on the day, and we recommend that churches or hosts add any additional costs (catering/venue etc) onto this.

We do ask that the host church or group cover travel and accommodation for Anya +/- the DOZ team. We would love to customise our plans to your needs and are happy to be accommodated in private homes or alongside your quests at your retreat venue.

It is the custom in most settings we present at to accept a special offering for the ongoing work of Anya McKee and the DOZ global ministry.

What are the payment terms?

We ask that travel and accommodation costs be covered in full prior to the retreat date and the per person contribution be payed within 7 days of the retreat.

Where have Daughter of Zion retreats been held?

DOZ Day retreats have been held in Australia, New Zealand and Turkey. In 2019, Anya will offer DOZ Online to women across the globe.

Can you help with advertising our DOZ day?

Absolutely. We can supply posters, invitation cards and a 3-minute slideshow presentation for your advertising needs.

What is the suggested schedule for a Daughter of Zion retreat?

We will work with your team to design a retreat schedule that meets your needs. The most basic schedule for a day retreat (below) includes simply the three sessions and a closing worship segment. For overnight or multi-day retreats, we recommend scheduling personal reflection time, opportunity for informal discussion or workshops, Q and A sessions, journaling opportunities and free recreation time.

Is personal prayer ministry available during the retreat?

Who caters for Daughter of Zion retreats?

The local church or retreat centre is responsible for arranging catering in most instances. However, in some situations we are able to recommend local caterers. Please note on your enquiry form if you would like our team to provide a catering package.

What is the ideal setting for a DOZ day / retreat?

The Story of the Daughter of Zion can be held in any boutique setting, including hotel function rooms, private homes, church halls, college campuses or camps. The presentation is enhanced by gardens or grounds where attendees can stretch their legs and find some quiet space between sessions. For large gatherings, we recommend convention centres and conference venues.

Has the Story of the Daughter of Zion been adapted as a Bible College Course?

Yes! With its theological insight, richly biblical content and intrinsically pastoral application, the Story of the Daughter of Zion is perfectly suited to bible college settings. Anya is available to teach the DOZ story as a short course in pastoral theology, Christian spirituality or as an introduction to the heavenly realm.
